

CCSWA Electronics' Recycling Fees and Information

As of January 1, 2009 the Centre County Solid Waste Authority will begin charging a **\$10** fee for TV's over 19 inches (screen size) received from residents. All other residential electronics will continue to be accepted free of charge.

In addition, we will now accept electronics from commercial establishments for a fee of **\$35** per ton (with a \$10 minimum charge, same as MSW). Please be advised that by law we can only accept up to **2,200** pounds per day per each individual or commercial entity. (Commercial establishments include schools, municipal/government offices, or anyone using computers in the course of their business). Businesses with larger quantities of electronics to be recycled should provide the Authority advanced notice of their projected delivery date to allow for special unloading options.

At this time we **will not** be accepting any TV's from businesses or other commercial establishments. Any inquiries from businesses with regard to recycling TV's should be directed to Dave Immel for consideration and possible "special arrangement".

All electronic items presented to the CCSWA for recycling are disposed of in a manner compliant with all local, state and federal regulations. No Certificates of Destruction or Recycling are issued for any electronics received by the CCSWA.
